Ridden Classes Judge: Mr K Roberts

Ring 1 - starting at 11am. All classes £4

1. **Best turned out:** pony, horse and rider
2. **Lead rein pony:** Mare or gelding 4 yrs old or over. Not exceeding 12.2hh. To be ridden by a child 9yrs and under.
3. **First ridden- snaffle bridle only:** Rider must be 11 yrs and under.
4. **Best riding pony:** Not exceeding 14.2hh
5. **Best local pony or horse:** Mare or gelding 4 yrs and over. Open to pony, horse and rider living within 6 miles of Llansilin.
6. **Best young rider:** For ponies/horses any height to be ridden by a child 16yrs and under. No lead reins allowed.
7. **Ridden M+M:** Any age to be shown in natural state

Ridden Championship: 1st and 2nd prize winners from classes 1-7 to compete.

Mounted Fancy dress: No entry fee, open to everyone. Prize awarded to the best costume.

Child that tries the hardest: A prize will be given by the organisers to the child that tried the hardest on the day.

Ring 2 - Starting at 11.30am. All classes £4

1. **Best turned out:** pony, horse and handler
2. **Young handlers:** For ponies up to 14.2hh led by a child 16yrs and under. Hard hats must be worn.
3. **Best local pony, horse and handler:** Mare or gelding 4 yrs and over. Open to pony, horse and handler living within 6 miles of Llansilin.
4. **Inhand M+M:** Any age to be shown in natural state
5. **Young stock class:** Yearling, two and three year old, any breed, any height.
6. **Inhand coloured pony/horse:** open to any age
7. **Inhand veteran:** Any height over 15yrs old

Inhand Championship: 1st and 2nd prize winners from classes 1-7 to compete

Best Local Championship: Winner from class 5 (ridden) and class 3 (Inhand)
